1. Read about the roaring twenties. Find photos at www.adoptaphoto.com that were taken during that time period. Create an illustrated report, slide show, or other multimedia presentation.
2. A typical photograph of a young person during the late 1800's and early 1900's was of a confirmation or first communion. What are these special occasions? What ceremonies of today compare? Find a recent photograph of a similar event. Also select a photograph from www.adoptaphoto.com. Write an illustrated report, or create a multimedia presentation about your findings.
3. Identify the type of automobile in the photo, "Old Car Ride." You will find it under Pennsylvania.
What is the time period? Search your family photographs to see if you can find pictures of people posing by automobiles. Identify the time periods. Why do you suppose people posed by cars? What have you posed by recently? Why? Using the photos you have found, write an illustrated report, or create a multimedia presentation about your findings using both your photos and those you find at www.adoptaphoto.com.
4. What is the type of uniform being worn in the photo,, "Lady in Uniform." You will find the photo under Indiana.
Determine the time period based on the style. Find examples of other old uniforms by researching books or the internet. Write an illustrated report, or create a multimedia presentation about your findings.
